He served in the United States Air Force and received degrees from Chico State University, California, and the University of Kansas. In his leisure, Ted was an avid University of Nebraska football fan and enjoyed reading, hunting, fishing, and traveling. His Sicilian heritage was very important to him and he was able to visit relatives in Sicily numerous times over the years.
