Parents, Guardians, and Colleagues:

A chance of freezing rain and sleet is forecasted for tomorrow morning beginning around 7:00 a.m. The timing and type of winter precipitation makes this a particularly worrisome forecast. It's possible nothing could happen or, if it does, freezing precipitation could occur after students have safely arrived to school.

On the other hand, if freezing precipitation does occur beginning around 7:00 a.m., it would likely be too dangerous to cancel school because buses would already have begun their routes and many people would have already arrived at school. As you know from my previous emails, we cancel school by 6:00 a.m. in order to avoid having students and adults travel more than necessary during inclement weather.

If school is in session, it is important to allow extra time for the commute. As a reminder, parents should use their best judgement on local road conditions when school is not cancelled and can excuse any absence if they feel driving conditions are unsafe near their location.
