Thank you for your continued support and for helping this to be such a successful school year! As we wrap up the school year, I wanted to pass along some information and a few updates.

Our teachers and administrators have been working incredibly hard on our school improvement process! We are excited about adopting new district-wide math resources and early childhood curriculum, and parents are free to stop by the district office to view the materials. They will be available at the district office May 21<sup>st</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> from 1:00-4:00 p.m.

LHS has made some modifications to their bell schedule for next year in order to provide additional professional development opportunities and support for students struggling more in math or English Language Arts. An email with details was sent via Skyward to LHS parents earlier this week.

In other school academic news, I have attached information about the state assessments and how to access your student's state assessment scores.

We are in the process of conducting a search for our new LHS principal, and representatives from all stakeholder groups are participating in the process. We appreciate outgoing LHS principal Steve Dike for his great work and 17 years of service to Lansing students!

The questions and schedule for our annual Parent Climate Survey will change this year due to requirements of the Kansas Educational Systems Accreditation (KESA) process. I'll send that out as soon as possible; and, when the survey is available, please take a few minutes to offer your input. We appreciate you helping us improve!
